

**ONE AND ONE STORY SCRIPT**

*Intro:*

EXT. PARK. DAY

The wind blows the leaves around the park in a crisp fall afternoon. The boughs of trees gently sway as a swing creaks slightly back and forth. The camera pans across, following the leaves until they encircle a young woman and blow off screen. The camera begins to zoom in on the woman's face, the woman beginning to show a warm smile. In the reflection of her eyes, the player can be seen standing a distance away from her.

JANE

You still love me, don't you Mark?

The camera fades out from her eyes and fades in from behind the player. JANE can be seen in the distance, her dress billowing in the breeze. The player holds out his hand, reaching for JANE to grab it even though she is far away.

MARK (PLAYER)

You know I do. Ever since we first met, I've never laid eyes on anyone else. You were my first love and I promised to always protect you. No matter how separated we may be, I would always be there for you.

The camera cuts back to a side shot of JANE. The sun is beginning to set and the lights are coming on in the park.

JANE mimics the player's pose and stretches her hand out as well; JANE giggles slightly. The wind is blowing her long hair, hiding her face as her shadow begins to fade in on the ground.

JANE

Oh, Mark. You've kept your promise even now and I thank you for that. We vowed no matter what happened we would always meet again, didn't we? I know you remember this park; it's where we first met. It was on a day just like today; we were much younger then, only beginning to understand the meaning of true love. The memory of our meeting has always resounded in my heart. It's one that I am glad to say is what's keeping me here now. But alas, we both must go.

The camera pans out to show both JANE and the player, their shadows are slowly stretching towards each other as the lighting around them begins to shift.

MARK

Our meeting again has only just started, why must we part so soon? I cannot fathom being away from you again. I need you, Jane.

JANE and the player both start to fade away, yet their shadows remain unchanged. The shadows have grabbed hands at this point and both characters are semi-transparent.

JANE

Mark, you silly man; you've always been one to overreact. Our time here is fleeting, but this isn't goodbye. Our journey has only just begun. It's time we let go of this tether and continue to our paradise. Besides, we will always still be here.

Leaves blow around JANE as she fades away completely. The camera zooms in on a side view of the player's face. His mouth has settled into a calm grin.

MARK

You're right, Jane. We may have left our place here, but everyone who enters this space will feel the warmth of the love we had.

The player fades away to nothing as the last words leave his mouth and the camera zooms out to show that their shadows still remain. The shadows begin to rise from the ground and take form. They embrace one another as the camera fades away.
